Members were inspired by the presentation from Pam Smithsted on using texture-medium in paintings. Smithsted demonstrated paintings on story boards to illustrate the use of each medium she used to create various painting effects.

Mediums such as Golden Molding Paste, Heavy Gloss Gel, Crackle Paste Durock & PVA Glue and impasto paints are among the choices to add texture to paintings. Methods include layering mediums and paints, sanding through layers to achieve some textures and use of random tools and techniques to scratch, move or shape the mediums for various effects. 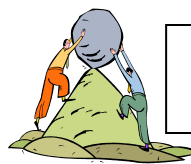
Rod Stroh has photographs hanging in the Antfarm for the month of June. See him there on First Friday.
