Real Life Art Show..by Becky Hawley

The next art show at the theater is Real Life. Do you have a piece that is either, realistic in style or portrays 'life' in some way? This is a theme almost everyone should be able to participate in! The show actually hangs May 29, but I would like to get an idea of the level of participation now. We want original work by you with a title to tie it to the theme, or the piece itself should be a depiction of reality.....in other words, the only thing I want to stay away from is complete abstracts, unless you can draw a very strong correlation to real life. As an example: Life Is Messy, Life Is Joyful or Life's Twists & Turns...the piece should feel strongly like the title.

I am asking (for this show only) that your piece to be for sale and that you consider a donation to the guild, if it sells. We have suggested 20% in the past, but will be happy with any donation you are willing to make. If you really want to show a piece Not For Sale, then we will show it for a \$15 donation/entry fee.

The deadline for your tag information is May 24, which should include: Title, medium and price. The work should either be delivered at 10am sharp on May 29, to the Sandy Actors Theatre or you'll need to make arrangements to get the work to me by May 28. bek.hawley@yahoo.com or 503-668-5590
